Check-In will be self-serve inside the building. All judging will be held in Ring 1. No practicing is allowed in the ring at any time. Dogs may be excused after their class has been judged, if not required for further judging.

Directions to Trial Site - Dream Big Training Center, 19681 Brandt Road, Lodi, CA 95240

- **From STOCKTON Area** – From Hwy 99 take Hwy 88 (2 exits north of Hwy 4) to Brandt Road. Turn right onto Brandt Road going east towards the mountains. Cross Clements, take first driveway on the left.
- **From SACRAMENTO Area** – Take Hwy 99 south to Acampo. Exit on W. Peltier (exit 270) and head east for 8 miles. Turn right onto Elliott Road for 3.5 miles. Elliot will become N. Tully Road as it passes through the town of Lockeford. Turn left onto Brandt Road. Cross Clements, take first driveway on left.



Additional Trial Information

- **CLASS TRANSFERS "Move-Ups" are allowed at these trials.** The request must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Emailed transfer requests may be submitted prior to the day of the trial (preferred). If you want to request a transfer on trial day, you must either come to the Trial Secretary desk, or both email and text to the Trial Secretary by the deadline. (Email is not checked on day of trial.)
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.

The Club reserves the right to adjust safety policies if necessary. **DO NOT COME TO THIS EVENT IF YOU FEEL SICK!** If the Club is able to replace your entries from the wait list, your entry fees will be refunded.

Crating Rules – Crating of entered dogs is allowed in the building provided these rules are followed:

- Please put a CLEAN towel and/or CLEAN mat under your CHAIR and CRATE to protect the matted surface and keep it clean.
- NO X-pens in the building.
- NO crate-aggressive dogs in the building. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave.
- A dog not entered in the trial is not allowed in the building.
- You may only crate in the marked crating area between the RED CONES! Space is limited. No dogs on the couch!
- If indoor crating fills up, additional crating is allowed on the patio on the side of the building. Handlers may also work out of their car. Regardless of where handlers crate their dog, it is each handler's responsibility to know when it is their turn in the ring, and to be ready to go in the ring when it is their turn.

Parking Information, Grounds, and Trial Procedures

- **NO OVERNIGHT & NO RV PARKING** is allowed. RV's are not allowed on the grounds.
- **NO SMOKING** is allowed on the grounds.
- **VEHICLES MAY NOT BE LEFT IDLING** in the parking area.
- **PARKING IS LIMITED.** Obedience exhibitors should not arrive more than one hour before earliest class. Rally exhibitors may arrive any time after 12:00 Noon. If your class is completed and the parking area is near capacity, please leave to give space to another entrant.
- **CLEAN-UP.** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Potty your dog in dog run or on gravel driveway. Do not potty dogs on grass, plants, barn, equipment, side of building, or back of building. Do not allow your dog to potty within 20' of the building.
- Every precaution for the safety of dogs and exhibitors will be exercised, but neither the Club nor the management will be responsible for loss or injury.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts (inside building).
- All dogs must be ON-LEASH at all times while on show grounds and parking areas unless in the ring for judging.
- Retractable leashes (Flexi-Leads) are permitted, but not to be extended beyond 6 feet in length indoors.
- **PLEASE KEEP DOGS QUIET.** If barking cannot be controlled, you will be asked to leave.
- Please stay away from the house area.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Consult the judging schedule (on previous page) for the time of judging. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club assumes no responsibility for this.
- **NO FOOD VENDORS** will be available at this event. Exhibitors should plan to bring their own snacks and beverages. Fast food is available approximately 15 minutes away.
- **WATER:** Well water is available and safe to drink. Note: Farm animals and cats are present on property. Please stay away from house area.
